

Instructions for writing the essay:

- The length of the essay should be approximately 3000 words. Essays should be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt, line space 1,5, and saved as Rich Text Format.
- Accepted languages for essays are English and Estonian.
- In the footnotes, additional information can be given relevant to the topic under discussion, but the footnotes should generally not be longer than five to ten lines.
- The sources should be indicated in the text, including the page numbers, in case of quotation as well as general reference, as follows: (Heffernan: 1993: 4), or (Heidegger 1993: 238–241). Quotations are indicated by means of ‘quotation marks’. When a whole paragraph is cited, it should be distinguished from the rest of the text by smaller font size.
- In the list of references at the end of each article, full names of the authors and editors, as well as the full titles of articles and books should be given, followed by the place of issue and the name of the publishing house. For example (books; articles in books; articles in magazines; articles in newspapers):
